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Travel Information-Visa

You are very likely to require a **visa** to visit India, unless there is a country specific reciprocal arrangement of visa waiver.

- Attendees should apply for a business visa when coming for the meetings. Find out here how to apply, what documents you need and which steps you need to follow.
- Accompanying family members can apply for a tourist visa. Here is more information.



Travel Information- Airlines

Air India is an airline that is safe, and with good service. But they are in the process of revamping a slightly dated fleet as they have been privatised after decades of being a government run airline.

Emirates and Singapore airlines offer excellent connections to Mumbai and many European airlines have direct flights to Mumbai as well.



Travel Information- Airports

Mumbai airport is well connected internationally.

If you are planning to stay on and visit other cities in the north of the country, you can also consider flying via Delhi, which services a wider set of airlines and routes. You will need to complete your immigration formalities at the first airport you land in, and re-check in your luggage unless you have a through check-in.

Delhi-Mumbai is approximately a 2 hour flight.

Both Mumbai and Delhi airports are large ones with considerable amount of walking depending on your gate number.

Remember, India is a country with 1.4 billion people, so expect crowds! "And we love coming to drop and pick friends and family at airports, even if it is at 2 am in the morning."

Airport pick up

Your room tariff includes a complimentary airport pick up

It is important that you share your flight details and any changes to it with the hotel to ensure that there is a smooth pick up. If you have shared your details with Shruti/Saloni, they have been passed on to the hotel. Without flight details the airport pick up will NOT be possible.

The hotel drivers will coordinate directly with you at the airport.


Breakfast

Breakfast will be served next to the conference venue at the Rooftop at the Trident on the 17th & 18th

Your accompanying guests are welcome to join the breakfast buffet at no charge, this will be operational from 7:30 am- 10 am

On the 19th, breakfast will be served at Jio World Convention Centre, the venue for our day's events. This is located around 45 minutes away from the Hotel

On the 20th, the hotel will give us packed breakfast for all-including accompanying guests, that can be carried on the tour



Local Transport

Transfers between meeting and dinner venues will be organized by ASCI on the 16th, 17th and 19th in mini buses. (On the 18th, everything is within walking distance).

On the 20th, the City tour has part walk- part bus sections. We will be picked up and dropped back to the hotel.

For the rest of the day on the 20th, which is free, you may make your own arrangements. It is recommended that you, in groups of 3-4, hire a private taxi from the hotel which can stay with you through the day and bring you to the venue for the Bollywood party by 6:30 pm. We will share recommendations on what you could see/do on the 20th. From the Bollywood party to the hotel, your transfer has been arranged by us.

Uber works reasonably well, except for at peak hours (8-10 am, 5:30-8 pm)

Tipping

No tipping is expected in public taxis.

The Uber app has a tipping option-usually a 5-10% tip can be added after the trip

Private taxis: for an 8-10 hour shift, you may tip your chauffeur around 500 rupees.

Some restaurants have a service charge of 10% included in the bill. In this case you are not expected to leave a tip unless you have had truly exceptional service. This is different from a service TAX (usually called SGST and CGST) which goes to the government.

If there is no service charge, then a 5-10% tip can be left for good service.



Travel information - Weather

The weather in Mumbai during March is typically warm, with daytime temperatures ranging between 32–35°C and nighttime lows of 25–26°C. Humidity levels are high, so lightweight fabrics like cotton or linen are ideal for staying comfortable outdoors. March is a dry month with no expected rainfall.

While meeting rooms are generally kept at a comfortable temperature, you may want to bring a light jacket or a shawl for added comfort indoors.

Some of our dinners are indoor-outdoors, and we will have mist-fans to cool the location.


Packing!

Overall don't pack too much because you are likely to find some good stuff to take back!




Travel information - Data & Roaming

India has some of the cheapest data plans in the world, but beware that the density of population may sometimes make network a bit patchy.

You can check for data plans from your provider or obtain a local SIM card on your arrival.

You can also buy an eSIM before your trip. It allows you to have mobile data and connectivity as soon as you land, without the hassle of finding a local SIM card. Many international eSIM providers offer plans specifically for India, making it easy to activate your service in advance.

Wifi will be available in the hotel and the conference rooms



Travel information - Miscellaneous

Food: Most restaurants in India do not serve beef or pork. Vegetarian and vegan food is abundantly available in all places. If you have any dietary restrictions or preferences, do not hesitate to let us know.

Shopping: Clothes and fabrics, spices, handicrafts, ayurvedic products are usually popular things to buy. Please note that powdered spices must be packed in your checked in luggage.

Taxis: While we are taking care of your local transport, please also note that Uber works in Mumbai. At peak times, it's a bit of a mess with frequent cancellations. Street taxis are available easily, but they are not air conditioned. Auto-rickshaws (similar to Tuk-tuks) only operate in the suburbs.

Safety: Mumbai is generally considered to be a safe city. All usual precautions that you might take in any large city, especially in tourist areas, should be exercised.
